

LENS SURGERY QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR DOCTOR

Here are some questions you should ask your ophthalmologist at the initial eye examination if you are considering Lens Surgery – also known as Refractive Lens Exchange:

- What are my presbyopia treatment options?
- Which type of replacement lens is best for me and why?
- What do I need to think about between now and treatment?
- Will I need to stop any of my medications before surgery?
- Is there anything I should or shouldn't do?
- Do I have any other eye conditions that could affect my treatment?
- Am I taking any medications that could complicate surgery, such as Flomax[®], Rapaflo[®], other alpha-blockers, or antidepressants?
- How long will it take to recover from surgery? When will I be able to resume normal activities?
- How much time will I need to take off from work?
- Is there anything I need to tell my family or caregiver?
